- 2) Certificate of completion of preparatory course for undertaking studies, as referred to in Asticle 60(4) of the Act od 12 December 2013 on Foreigners, lasting no less than 9 months, confirming proficiency in a given foreign language in four language skills: listening,m readingg, spekaing, and writing, at a language proficiency level of B2, C1 or C2.
- 3) A diploma of completion of first-cycle (bachelor's), second cycle (master's) or long-cycle master's studies issued by a foreig universitym containing information about the language of instruction. If the diploma does not include such information, an additional diploma suplement or a certificate confirming the language of instruction must be provided.
