

NBME SUBJECT EXAM RULES – 2025/2026

Dear Students,

For all of you who are willing to be assessed with the NBME exams, the University has decided to organize the examination session.

If you want to take the NBME subject exam, you have to respect following rules.

Exam date during winter examination session 2025/26 – 14.03.2026, 10:00 am, CDUM room 1.03 Exam date during summer examination session 2025/26 – 13.06.2026, 10:00 am, CDUM room 1.03

The exam will take place only if minimum 10 of examinees confirm the attendance. Students will be notified at least 7 days before the exam date if the exam is cancelled.

RULES FOR THE NBME EXAM

- 1. The participation in the exam is voluntary.
- 2. Every student can sit the NBME exam once during the examination session.
- 3. The available exams:
 - Behavioral Sciences
 - Biochemistry
 - Gross Anatomy only
 - Gross Anatomy + Embryology
 - Histology
 - Microbiology only
 - Microbiology + Immunology
 - Neuroscience
 - Pathology
 - Pharmacology
 - Physiology
 - Introduction to Clinical Diagnosis
 - Medicine (covers content of the Internal Medicine course)
 - Obstetrics and Gynecology
 - Pediatrics
 - Psychiatry
 - Surgery
- 4. The subject of the exam must cover current level of student's education.

In order to take the exam from a subject of your choice, you have to complete the classes beforehand. Moreover, students cannot choose a subject from which they completed only



one of the two semesters,

ex. a 1^{st} year student cannot sit to the Obstetrics & Gynecology exam or during the winter sessions the student of the 3^{rd} semester cannot take the Physiology exam.

5. Students, who want to take the exam, have to sign up for it by filling the online form:

Deadline: February 8th, 2026 – for the exam on 14.03.2026 Deadline: May 17th, 2026 – for the exam on 13.06.2026

- 6. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.
- 7. After the application deadline a student will be asked to confirm or cancel their attendance at latest 10 days before the exam date.
 - In case of not cancelling the exam, or not justify an absence for the exam date (according to the general MUL Rules & Regulations), the student will be banned in attending any NBME subject or CBS exam during next 6 months.
- 8. A student can only take the exam once during the examination session by the date indicated by the University.
 - There will not be any additional term or retake exams scheduled.
- 9. The exams are not graded, the score is only for the self assessment purpose.
- 10. A student who is in arrears with fees to the University will not be allowed to sit to the NBME/ CBS exams.
